<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prior to application ensure that the surface is dry at least 48hrs and all prior coats are finished and ready for final top application. • After application of Savon De Marseille™ it is suggested to let it permeate into the surface prior to wiping back with a cotton cloth. • Apply during temperatures between 10-30°C with relative humidity lower than 85%. • Lustre FX® recommends that specifiers, architects and builders appoint Lustre FX® trained artisans that have attended the Alchemy Academy training to ensure consistent finish to samples shown.
