Old Gold Olive Soap™ is a natural olive oil soap, with a distinctive rich, dark green—black appearance. This wax provides water resistance and is used in the application and maintenance of traditional plaster finishes; such as Tadelakt.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Dilute 1 teaspoon (5mg) of Old Gold Olive Soap™ to 1L of water. Apply with a spray bottle, plastic trowel and polish with a lint free cotton cloth.

- After application of Old Gold Olive Soap™ it is suggested to let it permeate into the surface, without drying prior to wiping back with a cotton cloth.
